- Valproic acid* is an effective medicine for epilepsy.
- Valproic acid can seriously harm an unborn baby when taken during pregnancy.
- Use effective contraception at all times during your treatment with valproic acid.
- It is important to visit your specialist to review your treatment at least once each year.

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IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR ALL GIRLS AND WOMEN WHO COULD BECOME PREGNANT

What you must do:

- Never stop taking valproate without discussing it with your doctor as your condition may become worse.
- If you are thinking about having a baby, do not stop using valproate or contraception before you talk to your doctor.
- If you think you are pregnant, do not stop using valproate. Make an urgent appointment with your doctor.
